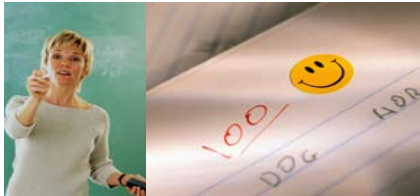


# SES Program Description
